Community Group Questions

- 1. Name one way you are different than most of your friends and family. What makes you unique...for better or for worse?**
- 2. Exercise:** Look up passages of Scripture that discuss the image of God. Use google, a concordance, or a digital Bible. What do we learn about the image of God from each of these passages?
 1. What does it mean to be made in the image of God?
- 3. People are uniquely made in the image of God. All other living creatures are not.**
 1. Do some human beings have more value than other human beings? Explain.
 2. How did God design humans different from animals in the following areas: spiritually, physically, relationally, psychologically (make a list). For each item, attempt to discern WHY specifically God made humans different in that way.
- 4. We included a lengthy section in our new constitution about the image of God.**
 1. Why did we do this? What are the consequences of NOT getting this right? Give specific examples in Scripture, history, and/or today of people who got this concept wrong.
- 5. How specifically were you created to multiply, subdue, and dominate?**
 1. Give examples of people who are not doing this? Avoid names for the sake of unity.
 2. Which of these do you most struggle with? How? Why?
- 6. How did God use this message to teach, train, challenge, encourage, or equip you?**
